The new 75,000-square-foot facility, will allow the YMCA to fully realize its mission-critical potential of serving individuals of all ages and stages of life.



Canandaigua is more than meets the eye. Did you know that approximately 1/3 of Ontario County residents are not making ends meet? More families find themselves employed, but with income constraints that do not allow for adequate quality of life. That is where the Y steps in.

The new facility is being created to specifically address:

- A local childcare desert where there is not enough childcare to meet the needs of area families
- An aging population that will increase exponentially through the end of the decade
- Growing numbers of families facing negative social determinants of health
- Increasing rates of obesity at all ages
- Lack of healthcare access

Stunning aquatics center will feature a 25-yard, six lane lap pool, fun splash pad and separate warm-water family pool. Whirlpool and dry sauna will be on deck.

Large kitchen will offer cooking classes and support Y programming. Space will be available for rentals.



The community center will focus on active older adult programming weekdays, switching to a family hub in the evenings and on weekends.



16 times around the second-floor track clocks one mile! The track loops the two gyms and is easily accessible by stairways or elevator.



At just under 3,000 square feet, the turf gym will offer a recreational space for young families to play soccer, tumble, flag football and more. The main gym provides extensive space for pickleball, basketball and more.

Three group exercise studios featuring different levels of intensity will overlook the aquatics center.
